

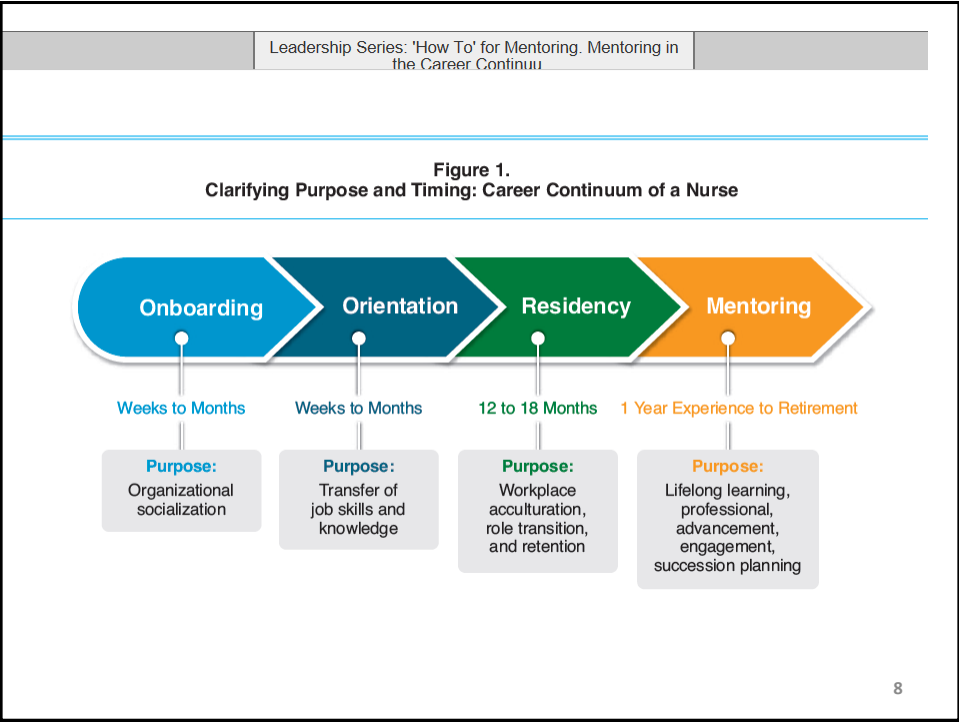



Methods

The learning elements

Self-assessment showed that the author's values and beliefs sit most comfortably with the Transformational Leadership Theory (Manley et al., 2008; Walsh et al., 2011). Key aspects of Transformational Leadership are the ability to communicate vision for the future, to generate energy to change, to encourage participative process, and to value staff for what they can input. Transformational leaders motivate others, including patients, to do more than they felt possible. Transformational leaders recognise that in order to deliver high quality patient care, an empowering culture needs to be created where communication, strong values (including a strong belief in the human potential), a tolerance of mistakes and mutual respect are paramount (Manley et al., 2008, pp.261–262). This widely accepted theory became the premise on which the undergraduate subject is based.

Considering these facets, the elements outlined in Box 1 were deemed valuable to include in the undergraduate subject.
